Things to know before getting started:

- It is not permitted to leave anything (trade items) inside of the geocaches as they may attract wildlife.
- You can use a GPS, iPhone or Blackberry to find the caches. To use a smartphone, download the geocaching app.
- Please respect nature by staying on marked trails - all geocaches are directly accessible from trails or public areas.
- Only Parks Canada staff may place geocaches in the park reserve.
- If geocaching with a large number of people, please split into groups of no more than 15 people.
- To be eligible for a geocoin (one coin per person), complete either all of the Top Ten Route or at least three out of the four of 'The Gulf Islands Survivor Challenges'. *Note: even if you do both routes, you still only receive one coin.
- Once you have completed your passport- to receive your centennial geocoin either: go into the Shaw Ocean Discovery Centre in Sidney BC, or tape the sides of this passport together, add a stamp and mail it to Parks Canada.
